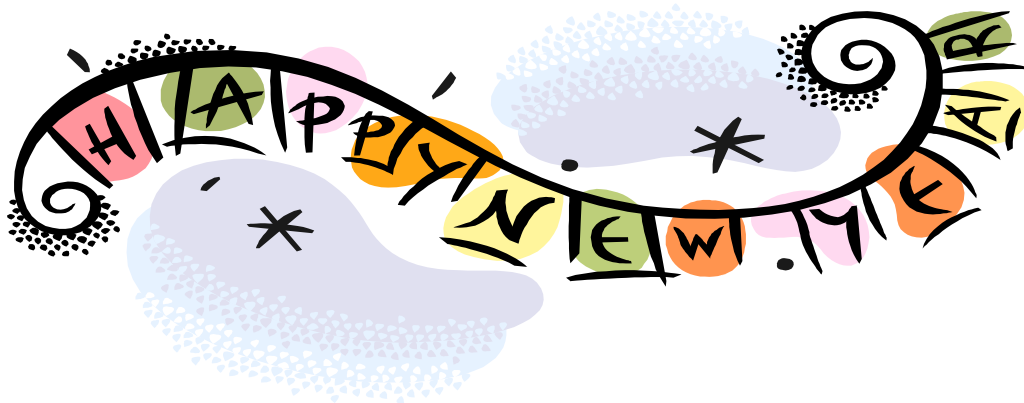
The new officers and delegates are excited and ready to serve.

Dinners this month will be announced at a later date.

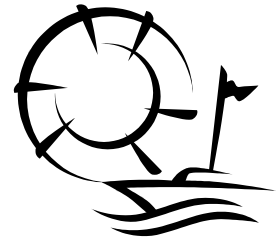

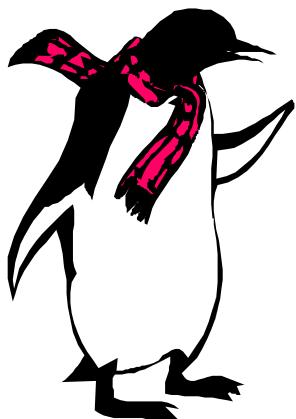
