The Safety Helm

The Harbor View Yacht Club annual Regatta/Homecoming/AYC Poker Run, is scheduled for June 25th, 26th and 27th 2010.

On Saturday **June 26th** between the hours of **1200 and 1700 hours**, **Free Safety Inspection** will be offered to all vessels during those times. As you might recall from last years event, the United States Power Squadron and the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary was on board to provide those inspections and decals at no cost the owner of the vessel. They have offered to return again this year to provide the same service as last year. The location where they will be stationed at will be announced at the opening of the event on Saturday June 26th.

Members from West Marine will have again, a trailer set up in order to purchase safety items necessary to complete the inspection of your vessel without leaving the grounds.

Last year, 62 vessels were inspected and decaled. This year it appears that we will surpass that number. Let everyone know that this great opportunity is being offered at this year's Regatta/AYC Poker Run. More information concerning the necessary safety gear to have on your boat can be found at either www.ohiodnr.com/watercraft or www.USCGboating.org.

A safety note to all Captains, The United States Coast Guard will be monitoring the Maumee River heavily on the week-end of the Regatta, the advice here is to stay in port and enjoy the ongoing excitement of the regatta. If you do leave port, make sure the **Sober Captain is at the Helm**.

One last word, adult beverage during the inspections **IS OPTIONAL**.
